Message to all Dysart Lake associations:

As you know Dysart is debating about downgrading their septic program from a level 4 inspection to a level 3 (no Pump Out)

C.H.A. has studied this topic for almost 10 years now and feels that it would be a mistake that will hurt our lakes

As you will see in the attached info - by removing the pump out the inspections will miss between 22 and 32% of the problem systems I encourage you to let the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and your council member know that there should not be a downgrade in how our lakes are protected.
